# Food Intolerance

- A Laboratory Blood Test for detection of Food Intolerance



## Food Intolerance-Basics

Symptoms of Food Tolerance are generally less serious and often limited to digestive problems such as bloating of abdomen after eating certain types of foods, tiredness or headache for no apparent reason.

## Food Intolerance symptoms and signs

- An imbalance in intestinal flora could be causing the symptoms commonly associated with **Irritable Bowel Syndrome (IBS)**. Such an imbalance may cause any of following symptoms:
  - Stomach cramps
  - Abdominal pain
  - Constipation
  - Bloating of abdomen
  - Headache
  - Lethargy
  - Flatulence
  - Diarrhoea
  - Back Pain
- To evaluate Food intolerance **an in-vitro semi quantitative test to detect IgG** antibodies against various food items is the most reliable way to identify foods that cause such symptoms.

## Fecal Calprotectin Stool Test for diagnosis & Monitoring of Inflammatory Bowel Disease

Calprotectin is a calcium-binding protein found within neutrophils which influx into the bowel during inflammation. Calprotectin levels may be elevated in patients suffering from **INFLAMMATORY** bowel diseases (IBD) but not in non-inflammatory bowel diseases e.g. **IRRITABLE** bowel syndrome (IBS).

  - MONITOR** IBD therapy & to **DETECT** relapse

## PRESIDENT'S PEN

Indian Medical Council Amendment Bill 2019 which provides for suppression of Medical Council of India for a period of two years with effect from 26th September, 2018 was passed by both the houses of parliament. The bill proposes to increase the number of members in the Board of Governors to 12 from the existing 7. Now very soon we will be witnessing the National Medical Commission bill to be placed in parliament. There are some concerns about this NMC bill :

**Bridge course** - Practitioners of other system of medicine (AYUSH) should not be allowed to practice allopathic system of medicine. Poor people in rural areas should not be allowed to be treated by these half baked doctors. They also deserve to be treated by qualified medical personnel. Ayush ministry is being created for promotion and growth of alternative systems of medicine. At one end Govt is opening hundreds of new AYUSH colleges to promote traditional and alternative systems of medicine and on the other hand planning to convert them into allopathy by introducing a bridge course. That means Govt has no confidence in alternative systems of medicine or feels they are not completely dependable.

If AYUSH doctors can not treat with their system of medicine then why we are producing such kind of doctors and Govt should stop admission in AYUSH course in all these medical colleges and let all medical colleges in country be allowed for teaching and training of allopathic medicine rather than producing substandard allopathic doctors by means of bridge course.

**Autonomy** - Autonomy of National medical commission should not be compromised and there should be equal number of elected representatives. If nominated ones outnumbered the elected ones then there are chances of controlling of power by Govt which is also not in good taste.

**Capping of Fees** - After the NEET entrance exam for medical colleges it was thought that only deserving candidates will be admitted in medical colleges but the exorbitant fees in private medical colleges forced only the rich with very less mark to get admitted and poor with much higher rank are sidelined. Govt should bring some regulatory mechanism to check this steep increase in fee by private medical colleges. Capping of fees in private medical colleges can be answer to this. If one has to shell out such humongous amount (1 to 2 crores) to become doctor there are doubts of him practising ethically later.

### **Issues of Bio medical waste ::**

Recently it has come to the notice that few medical establishments have been served closure notice for not being registered with DPCC. DMA and branches have organised number of camps for registration with DPCC and many members got registered through these camps. Teams from DPCC will soon be doing surveys throughout Delhi for registration with DPCC so all those who couldn't get their establishment registered are requested at the earliest in their own interest .

DMA is taking up issues of bar coding, redefining biomedical waste, misuse of plastic material with State Government and Central Government. Dr Kamal Parwal and Dr RK Gupta are assisting DMA office with logistics.

### **Issue or NOC from Fire**

As all of you are aware that NOC from fire department is now to be required for renewal of license.

DGHS has issued Show cause notice to all the Nursing Home in Delhi, if nursing homes don't submit NOC from fire department their registration will be suspended or not e renewed. As per fire norms Nursing homes are classed as institutional building, so the requirement to obtain in a fire NOC from the fire department cannot be fulfilled. This means approximately 20000 indoor beds will be removed from the health care system of Delhi.

At present Nursing homes are allowed in residential building as per MPD2021 as utility services so fire safety norms should be according to residential building and not as institutional buildings. Delhi Medical Association is working hard to get exemption of fire NOC for buildings of less than 15 m height. Though all non structural changes will be done for fire safety but need not to obtain NOC.

Registered Nursing Homes will receive a legally drafted reply for the Show cause notice issued by DGHS, please submit your individual reply to DGHS accordingly.

### **Relief sought from authorities**

All the existing hospitals registered with the Delhi government as nursing homes who are existing in the residential premises in residential areas may be allowed to continue as per the fire safety norms as the residential buildings as far as a structural modification are required as per residential norms and the renewal may be granted as per the previous norms without no objection certificate from the fire department.

The fire department should be instructed not to demand the no objection certification of residential buildings which are used for nursing homes if they are existing in less than 15 meter height

At the outset we confirm and promise that every hospital/nursing home/clinics situated in residential areas with less than 15 meters shall be communicated to adhere to all fire safety norms and install all fire safety equipments to ensure the safety of patients and visitors even without the no objection certificate and structural changes and shall furnish a certificate from a 3<sup>rd</sup> party inspection ensuring fire safety.

DMA has sent mail to all Nursing Home owners to send a reply to show cause notice served by DGHS.

### **Issue of Assault :**

Issues of assault against medical professionals is a very sensitive issue which concern all of us and we all are committed to show a united front on this. Government as well private hospitals are witnessing such incidents all across the states. After the Calcutta incident where a intern was beaten so badly that he has to battle his life. OPD services for one day were paralyzed across India. But the incidents are recurring again and again. On Doctors day one intern was assaulted at Hindu Rao Hospital to the extent that suturing at head was to be done followed by strike by the residents and interns. FIR has been registered against miscreants but they have not been arrested as yet.

In spite of legislation in the form of Delhi Medicare Service Protection Act 2008 the incidents of assault against medical professionals and institutions are on the rise. Doctors are being assaulted not because of their fault but because of administration issues like poor infrastructure, non availability of wheel chair, stretcher, medicines and non functional lab services, ECG machine, X ray , CT scan etc. which are beyond the control of doctor on duty. Unless and until budgetary allocation to health is increased these types of incidents will continue to occur. There should be some guidelines for number of duty hours for residents, number of patients per doctor to examine in OPD in duty hours.

### **Media role :**

Even as Bihar mourns the deaths of over 150 children owing to Acute Encephalitis Syndrome (AES), a section of media milked the grave situation to boost TRP. One of the journalist irresponsibly barged into ICU of one of the hospitals treating most of the children for live reporting. She spoke loudly and grilled a busy doctor. She also interviewed a relative of an unwell child. This incident of parachute journalism sensationalising the AES outbreak came under heavy attack on social media. DMA take a note of this incident wrote to Press council of India(PCI), National Broadcasting Standard Authority of India (NBDA), Aaj Tak authorities.

## HONY. STATE SECRETARY'S PEN...

Dear Colleagues,

On the occasion of Doctors Day I congratulate all the members, office bearers, executives, awardees and leaders of Delhi Medical Association. I feel pride that our members have excelled in their respective fields and Medical Fraternity in Delhi has brought laurels for the nation from time to time. Everybody reiterated their commitments, dedication and sincerity to the society.

Members of Delhi Medical Association are facing various problems and issues pertaining to their establishments. One of the recent and major issue is Fire NOC. We have constantly touch with the officials Chief Minister & Minister of Govt. Of NCT Delhi and expert in this field and filed the suitable reply to the authorities.

Delhi is a unique metropolis in the world having a population of more than 1.5 crores and is the Capital of the Country. More so, it is the health capital of the country. It is submitted that we are immensely contributing to the health care delivery system along with Government and non-governmental sector. It is relevant to note that the private medical sector remains the primary/readily available source of health care for 70% of households due to poor infrastructure, long wait times, distance, inconvenient hours of operations, etc. at governmental centers/hospitals/dispensaries etc. Private sector has 28000 beds in the capital.

But DHS has suddenly gave a notice to nursing homes/ hospitals to immediately submit NOC from fire department and the height which was 15 meter height till today for free from NOC now reduced to 9 meter and more than 9 meters height have to submit NOC from fire department to DHS.

Although there is no ground available under the Registration Act to cancel an existing registration of nursing homes/hospital on the ground of non-submission of fire safety clearance certificate.

There is not even a requirement for the applicant to submit the fire safety clearance certificate. Even at the time of grant of renewal of the registration, DGHS never asked to submit a fire safety clearance certificate in respect of the building in which doctors running their medical establishment. It is not understood as to how their registration can be threatened to be cancelled on ground of non-submission of fire safety certificate when there is not even a requirement of submitting the said certificate for grant of a registration or renewal thereof.

In any event the power and jurisdiction to decide whether an institutional building complies with fire safety requirements or not lies exclusively with the jurisdiction of department of Delhi fire service and not with DHS.

At the end I am very sorry to write that the Govt. is not interested in protecting the doctors from the assault by the relatives of patients. The fire of Calcutta episode is not yet finished an another beaten episode has happened in Hindu Rao Hospital and no arrest has taken place till today.

Friends, There was hardly any mention of healthcare in Union Minister of Finance Nirmala Sitharaman's maiden budget speech. It did not touch upon even flagship schemes of the Narendra Modi government as expected by experts.

Instead, she just gave a passing reference to the sector, stating that according to the vision presented in the interim budget, a healthy society would remain an area of attention for the government, which she attributed to factors like Ayushman Bharat and well-nourished children and women.

The budgetary allocation for the Department of Health and Family Welfare has been increased 15 per cent to Rs 62,659 crore (BE 2019-20) from the Revised Estimate for 2018-19.

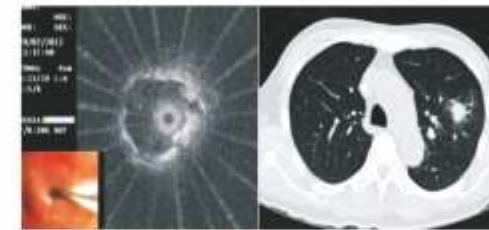

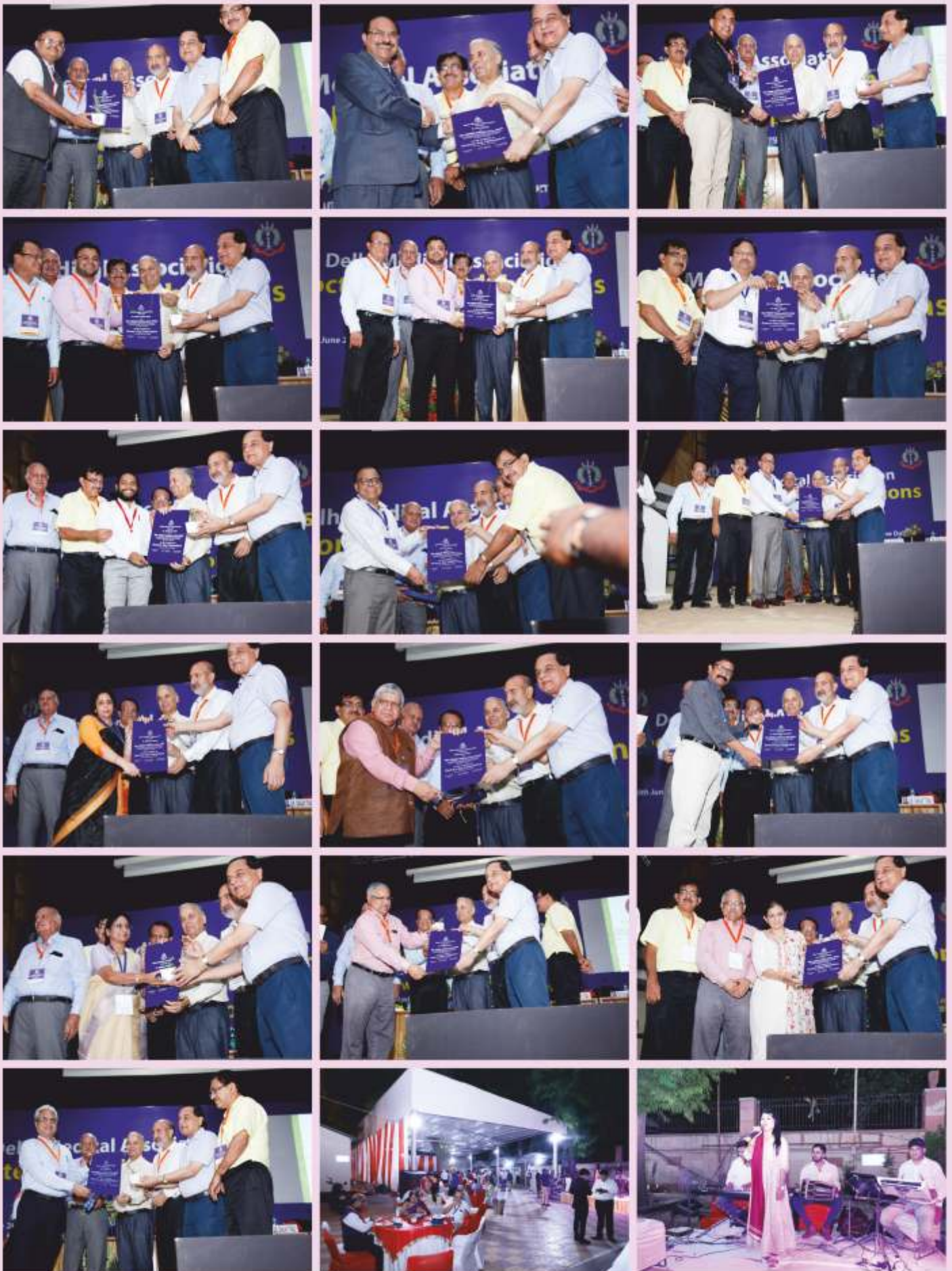

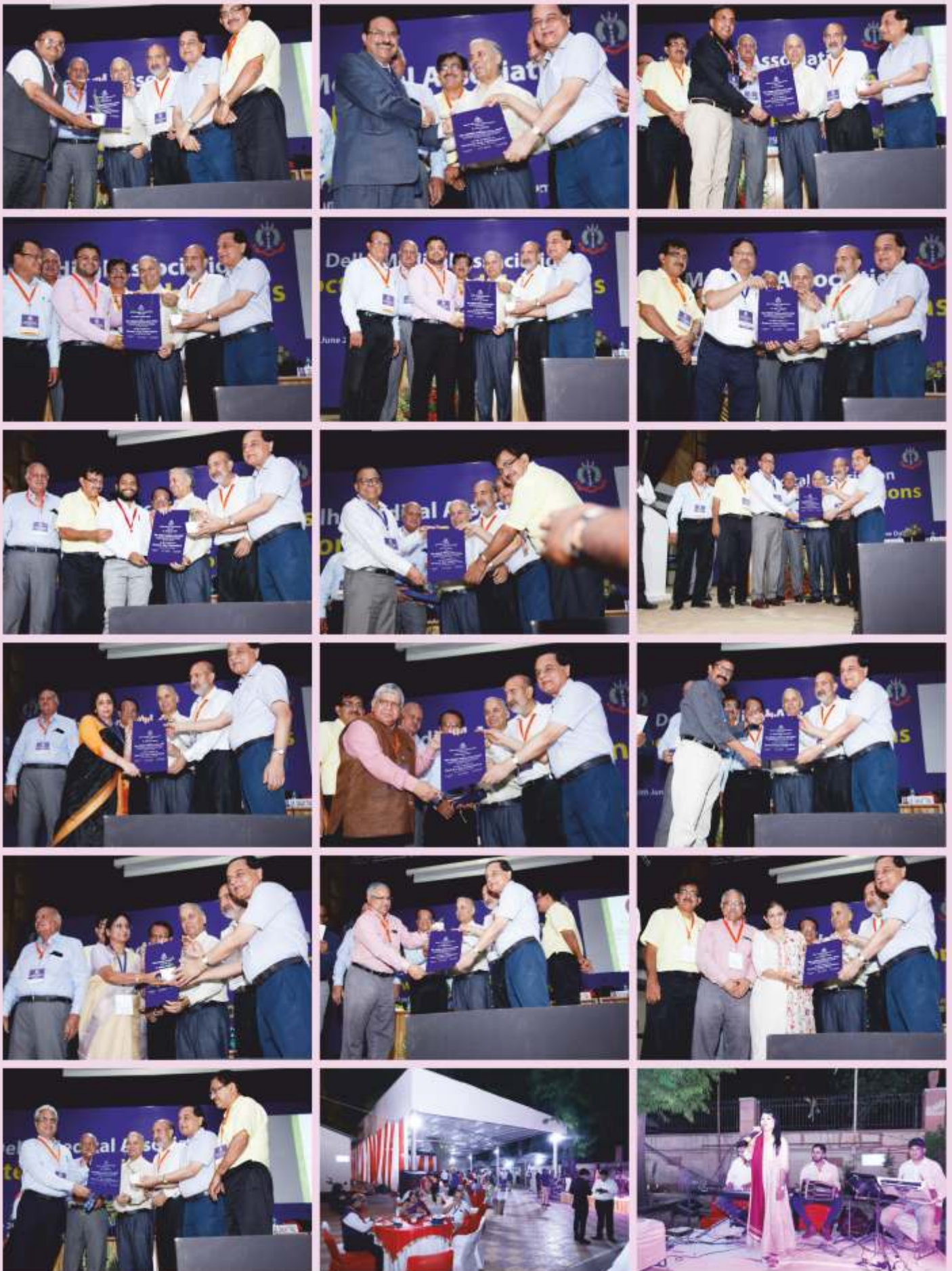

- In case of discontinuation of regular services of CBWTF, proportionate rate will be deducted by Health Care Facilities.
- In case of any complaint of overcharging, action would be initiated as per rules.

### Decisions of Committee headed by Member Secretary, DPCC on 17/06/19 in Delhi Secretariat for implementation of bar code system in Health Care Units operating in Delhi.

1. DPCC shall develop a central software for NCT of Delhi which shall be used by CBWTFs as well as HCFs. For this a domain expert shall be identified for preparing RfP and for selection of vendors for preparation of software. The working of the software shall be monitored by DPCC through the vendor. This shall also lead to the rationalization of the rates. This exercise is to be done in a time bound manner.
2. In the meantime, CBWTFs shall rationalize their rates for barcoding.
3. The whole process shall be completed within 6 months.
4. In view of the above decisions and timelines, DPCC shall request CPCB and MOEF&CC for extending the deadline for implementation of barcode system in Delhi for one year i.e. by 27th March, 2020.

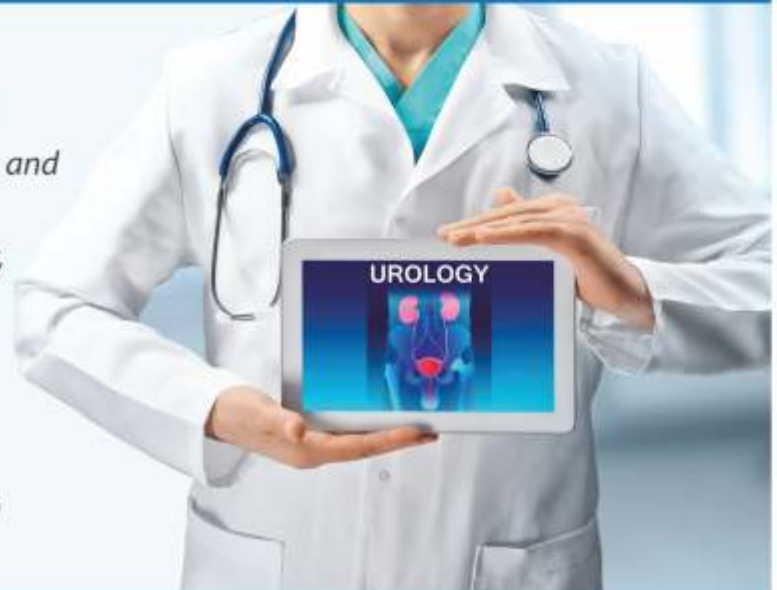
