## Palliative Care at Sir Ganga Ram Hospital

Palliative Care is a specialised field of medicine that focuses on providing care for individuals suffering from serious, life-limiting illnesses such as cancer, chronic heart failure, chronic kidney disease, chronic obstructive pulmonary disease (COPD), interstitial lung disease (ILD), and progressive neurological disorders like dementia, stroke, and Parkinson's disease. The primary goal of palliative care is to enhance the quality of life for both patients and their families as they navigate the complex physical, psychosocial, and spiritual challenges associated with incurable, chronic, progressive, and advanced diseases.

This approach emphasises the relief of distressing symptoms, including pain, nausea, fatigue, loss of appetite, oral ulcers, non-healing wounds, insomnia, and general weakness, among others. Palliative care is personalised to meet the unique needs of each individual and often involves a collaborative effort from various specialists, such as physiotherapists, counsellors, nutritionists, psychologists, and occupational therapists, to develop a comprehensive care plan.

The department has two consultants, three DNB-PG students, and two nursing officers. The palliative care team works in partnership with the parent treating unit to provide an additional layer of support for the patient and caregivers. The team delivers impeccable symptom management, expert communication regarding goals of care, treatment options, and advance care planning, and assists families in navigating difficult disease trajectories.

### What is Palliative Care?

Palliative care is a specialised form of care for patients and their caregivers who suffer from serious life-limiting illnesses like cancer and chronic liver & kidney disease. It focuses on improving the quality of life of patients and their caregivers by managing difficult physical and psychosocial symptoms. It is generally initiated alongside the curative treatment.

### Who provides Palliative Care?

Palliative care is provided by a multidisciplinary team that includes a palliative care specialist, trained nurses, social workers, physiotherapists, nutritionists, occupational therapists and spiritual advisors, who work together to support the patient and their family throughout the trajectory of the disease.



## How is Palliative Care different from Hospice Care?

While both focus on comfort, palliative care can be provided at any stage of a serious illness, not just the end of life. Hospice care is specifically for patients who are in their last 6 months of life and have decided to stop curative treatment or are not fit for any disease-directed therapy.

## Is Palliative Care Covered by Insurance?

Yes, palliative care is usually covered by Mediclaim and most private insurance plans if the patient is admitted.

## How do I know if I need Palliative Care?

If you have a serious illness and are experiencing symptoms that affect your quality of life, palliative care might be beneficial. It can help manage pain, stress, other distressing symptoms and help you and your family cope better.

## Where can I receive Palliative Care?

Palliative care can be provided in various settings, including hospitals, outpatient clinics, nursing homes, hospice and at home.

## What are the common symptoms managed in Palliative Care?

- Severe pain
- Breathing difficulty
- Cancer-related fatigue
- Constipation
- Anxiety
- Insomnia

### • NEWER LIPID LOWERING DRUGS

Cardiovascular Disease (CVD) is a leading cause of deaths worldwide as well as in India. The major risk factor is the Increased Low Density Lipoprotein (LDL) component of Cholesterol.

Multiple drugs especially Statins have been successful in reducing LDL to healthy levels/concentrations in blood leading to reduction of atherosclerotic events.

There are multiple established Anti-Lipid drugs like Statins, Niacin, Fibrates, Ezetimibe, Bempedoic Acid, Glitazar, Bile acid resins, Omega 3 fatty acid etc.

### THEN WHY NEED OF NEWER DRUGS TO LOWER LIPIDS

#### LIMITATIONS OF ESTABLISHED THERAPY ARE:

- Adverse effects like Myopathy, GI Intolerance, DM-2, Deranged Liver enzymes are common.
- Most importantly, Target level of LDL is not achieved consistently. Patients requiring Newer Drugs:
- Target level not achieved by current therapy
- Most patients with Heterozygous Familial Hypercholesterolemia (1 in 200-500)
- Almost all patients with Homozygous Familial Hypercholesterolemia
- Statin Intolerance.
- Drug interactions with Statin

### COMMON NEWER LIPID LOWERING DRUGS

#### INCLISIRAN

- An siRNA Therapy which silences PCSK gene in

liver reducing PCSK protein production. This increases LDL receptors leading to Lower LDL

- Doses: Initial dose then second dose after 3 months followed by 2 doses per year at 6 month interval.
- Subcutaneous injection by HCP.
- Reduces LDL-C by 50-60%.
- Caution in liver disease & rarely Flu like symptoms.
- Cost is about ₹90K/ dose marketed by Novartis

#### PCSK9 INHIBITORS

- A Monoclonal antibody that degrades PCSK9 proteins in liver & blood, thus enhancing LDL Clearance.
- Subcutaneous injection every 2-4 weeks by self administration. Reduces LDL-C by 50-60%.
- Generally safe but liver enzymes monitoring is safer or rarely Inj site reaction.
- Cost is about ₹18K/dose available in India marketed by Dr Reddy's Lab.

**Few other Newer Anti-lipid drugs like LOMITAPIDE**, an MTP inhibitor, is only available for research purposes, MIPERSEN an Antisense oligonucleotide not available in our country.

**To summarise**, Among newer lipid lowering drugs, Inclisiran & PCSK Inhibitors are promising. Both are well tolerated. Inclisiran has fewer doses i.e. twice in a year. But the cost is prohibitive at the moment. Liver & kidney function to be monitored frequently in both drugs. Pregnant & Nursing mothers should avoid both drugs due to lack of safety data.



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

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
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
